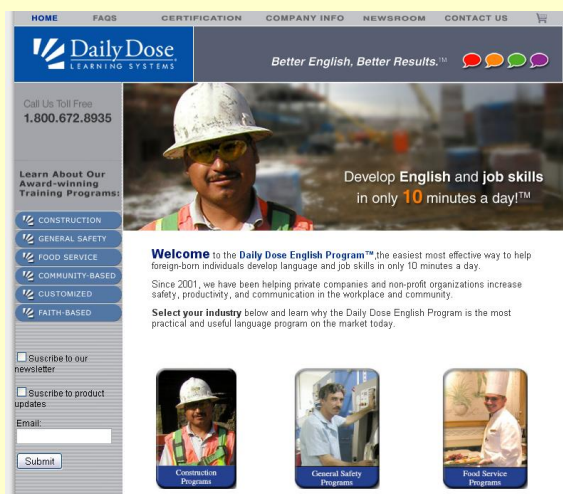

In occasions when a near-miss situation has occurred, the Facilitators have taken the opportunity to highlight the Safe Work practices associated with that near-miss by presenting the poster that relates to the type of near miss situation. Because they review safety every day (and learn English at the same time) the safety is forefront on their minds and their understanding is much better. Not only does the Daily Dose increase language and safety knowledge, but it also helps create another level of communication and relationship between the participants and management. “
